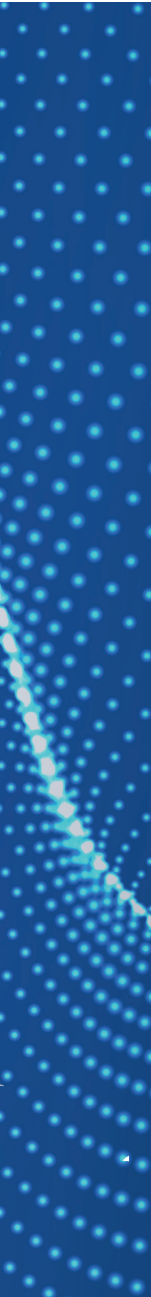
## Empowering Tomorrow's Innovators

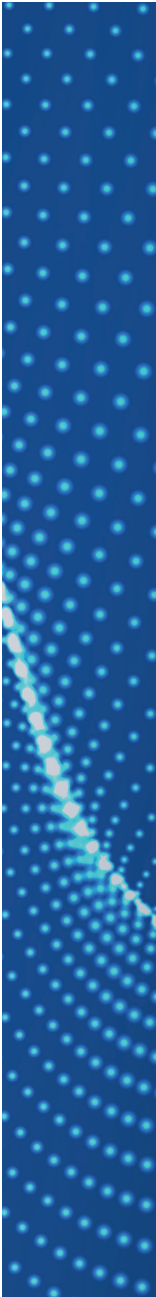

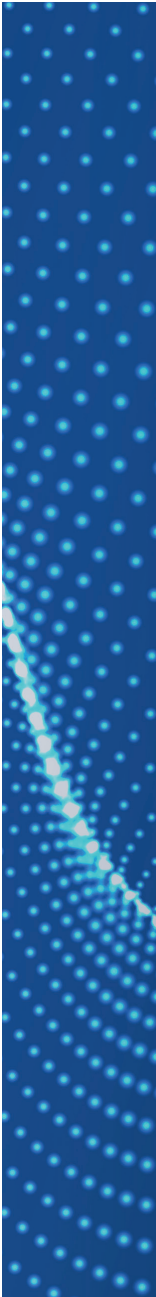

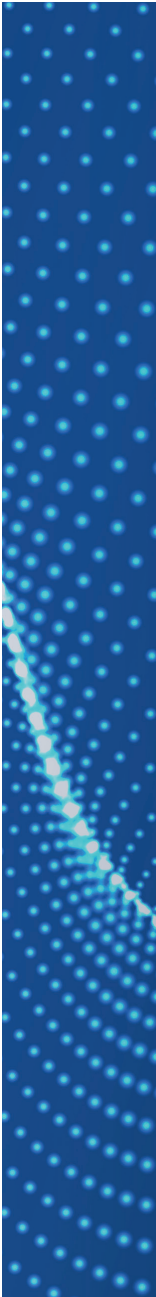
